5 **AGAINST NUCLEAR ENERGY**

6  
7 Scotland has some of the best potential sites for renewable energy generation in the whole of Europe, especially in  
8 wind and wave power generation. Currently around half of Scotland's energy needs are met by three aging nuclear  
9 power stations.

10  
11 The recent UK government energy review, while recognising the potential for renewable energy, indicated that the  
12 government still believes there is a role for nuclear energy. This would mean the construction of new nuclear  
13 power stations in Scotland

15 The EFGP therefore welcomes the foundation of SANE (Scotland Against Nuclear Energy) by Robin Harper,  
16 Scottish Green Party Member of the Scottish Parliament, and Patricia McKenna, Irish Green Member of the  
17 European Parliament, and supports SANE's campaign to "ensure that Scotland's future electricity needs are met by  
18 sustainable means instead of nuclear power".
